Anna- a rainbow Barbie dress

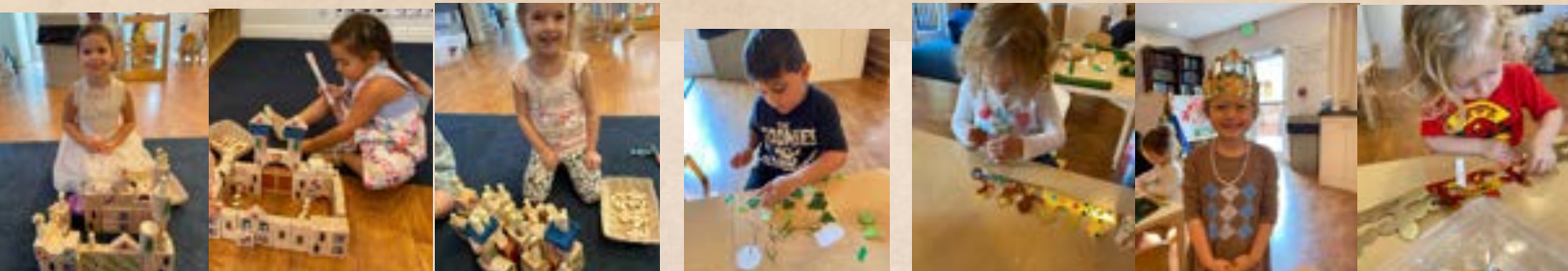
Bentzion- lots of things and new glasses

Leah- a mouth and a crab and a special baby



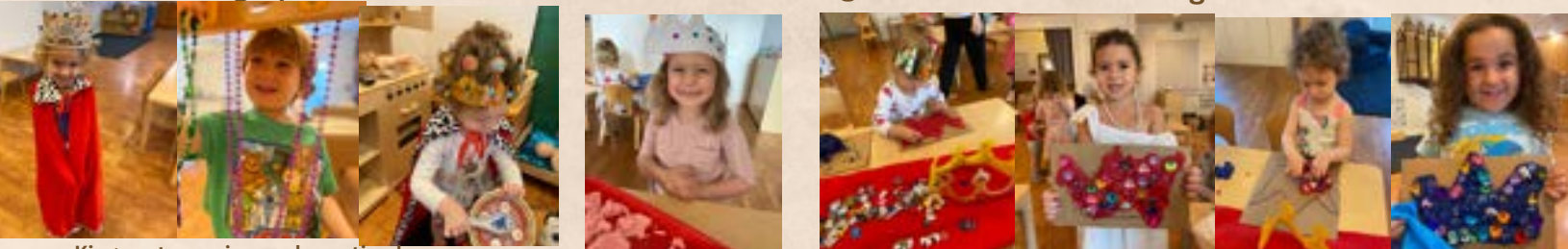
Our sensory table had green peas (grass) and lots of mini crowns and treasures. We were very busy searching, scooping and pouring all week.

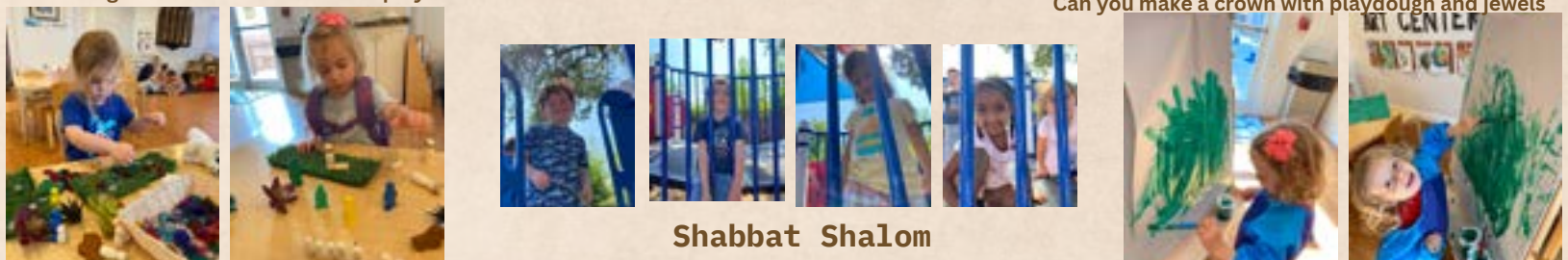
